IOOA's members support the return of the second tier imbalance multipliers to the pre-existing multipliers (+/- 5%) for reasons outlined in multiple letters submitted previously by IOOA on this issue. We also support the CRU's suggestion that should shippers misbehave when the multipliers are set at the pre-existing level (+/- 5%) that the multipliers would be increased in a stepwise approach (e.g. steps of 5%) to incentivise appropriate shipper behaviour.
