Vermilion Energy supports the return of the second tier imbalance multipliers to the pre-existing multipliers (+/- 5%) for reasons outlined in the earlier email below.

We also support the CRU's suggestion made at the CMF on 31 January 2018, that should shippers misbehave when the multipliers are set at the pre-existing level (+/- 5%) that the multipliers would be increased in a stepwise approach (e.g. steps of 5%) to incentivize appropriate shipper behavior.
