Tynagh Energy welcomes the opportunity to respond to the Business Rules for Code Modification A068 (Balancing) consultation.

In keeping with the numbered headings in the Business Rules document, please find comments below on each section.

2. Interim Imbalance Cashout

In relation to 2.3, Tynagh would like to reiterate it is unfair that imbalance charges may be incurred from 02:00-05:00 when a generator may be instructed to change its plant running, but is unable to renominate its gas position. Tynagh asks that the calculation of First and Second Tier Imbalance Quantities only considers the period of 05:00-02:00 of a Gas Day.

In relation to 4.4 (a) and (b), TEL is satisfied that credits/costs will be settled on a monthly rather than annual basis. TEL is unable to comment on the proposed monthly Neutrality Charge until a detailed calculation is provided.
