Gas Networks Ireland operates and maintains Ireland's €3bn, 14,725km national gas network, which is considered one of the safest and most modern renewables-ready gas networks in the world.

- o Drive the promotion of hydrogen and the development and implementation of a communications plan to drive awareness internally and externally.
- o Engagement and representation with European agencies and industry collaboration partners.

- o Coordination and assistance in the development of business plans and commercial development proposals.

- o Support the hydrogen team in tracking and managing the hydrogen budget.
- o Develop and progress projects and applications for external funding support under National or EU funding schemes.
- o Coordination and assistance in the development of business plans and commercial development proposals.
- o Other duties as may be assigned from time to time.
