The Services Team within Service Delivery is responsible for managing all meter related work such as customer connections and relocations, meter maintenance, replacement, and decommissioning.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Completing all field Siteworks activity as assigned
- Using Maximo, Click and Syclo technologies to manage the end to work
- Reporting back work execution status to the Siteworks Manager via the Syclo handheld technology
- Ensuring that all works are carried out within GNI procedures [Meter fit Procedures etc.]
- Ensuring GNI appointment policy lease with customer using Mobile technology
- Attending all Leak Management training Safe Pass course Manual Handling etc.
- Working within the safety guidelines established by Gas Networks Ireland
- Ensuring compliance with all health and safety legislation and directives.

- Being available for First Response and outages as they arise
- Liaising with Emergency Service when required.
- Mentoring and leading new fitters and apprentices.
- Assist in the roll out of implementation of new technologies and procedures.
- Ensure all work is carried out in accordance with documented GNI procedures, risk assessments and work instructions and where unsure to seek confirmation from their line manager.

- Participate in on-call rota as required
